

Website Privacy Policy

Inspirational Legacies Wellness & Media LLC | Effective August 5, 2026

This policy explains how information is handled when you visit this website or contact the practice online. It does not replace the Notice of Privacy Practices that governs protected health information created or maintained in connection with health care services.

1. Scope

This Website Privacy Policy applies to the public website for Inspirational Legacies Wellness & Media LLC at inspirationallegacies.com, including pages, forms, and links operated through the website. It does not govern information handled exclusively by an insurer, another provider, a third-party directory, or a separate platform under that party's own privacy terms.

2. Information the Website May Collect

Website messages are intended for basic inquiries and scheduling. When a secure client portal is available, clinical documents and sensitive communications should be sent through that portal.

5. Emergencies

6. Cookies and Analytics
